NON-CONTESTABLE & CONTESTABLE FUNDING

The Wellington KiwiSport Regional Partnership Fund is distributed via a non-contestable and contestable process.

The non-contestable process is just that, non-contestable. Sport Wellington will look to identify and fund appropriate lead agency/agencies for non-contestable projects as identified by way of community consultations and submissions. There is no application process for this fund. Non-contestable projects are those in grey in section one of the [Wellington KiwiSport Regional Partnerships Fund Plan](#).

The contestable process and fund is available for all schools, sports, clubs and community organisations in order to increase the number of school-aged children participating in organised sport. Applications for this fund can be found [here](#). These applications are to be submitted *electronically* only.

During the assessment process, the KiwiSport Internal Assessment Panel

will be able to identify proposals that may better fit within a non-contestable project.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FUNDING

We would like to remind applicants about the requirements that are necessary for KiwiSport funding. All applications/projects must include verification of *partnerships*, a *strategic or business plan*, evidence of *financial contribution* and how your project will *impact* on more school-aged children participating in organised sport.
