Chalk Bombing - Best Practise Model

To find out what stencils you may want to borrow and use in your playground, we recommend running a chalk bombing session with your tamariki. Use chalk to draw up some games/markings using the ideas below and then sit back and see which ones the tamariki use the most. You could also give them some paper and pens, as well as chalk so they could create their own markings and designs.
